Policy Title: Readmission

Students who withdrew from the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) program and wish to re-enroll must petition the DNP Council for reinstatement. The student must submit a letter through the DNP Program Coordinator to the DNP Council explaining why she/he was unsuccessful or withdrew from the program and why she/he believes that she/he can be successful if readmitted.

The DNP Council will consider the request at its next scheduled meeting. The DNP Council will take into consideration time since last enrolled, academic record, and other pertinent information. A majority vote of the DNP Council members is required for reinstatement in the DNP Program. The DNP Council may recommend additional course work as a stipulation of readmission. If readmitted, the DNP Coordinator will notify Student Affairs and forward a revised degree plan to the Student Affairs Office for processing.
