Policy Title: Unprofessional* Clinical Performance

Policy

Unprofessional* practice and/or behavior in the clinical setting are grounds for failure of the course or other appropriate action. (See Policy G5010 Professional Conduct for rules regarding professional practice in the clinical settings/area).

Procedure

- A. The faculty will inform the student in writing that he/she has performed unacceptably in the clinical setting and is in danger of failing the course.
- B. A second unacceptable clinical practice incident will result in the faculty informing the student in writing that he/she has failed the course, why he/she failed and that the student will receive a grade of "F". The student will not be able to withdraw without penalty as a result of this action.
- C. Violation of safe clinical practice, inappropriate/unprofessional behavior(s), and/or unsatisfactory clinical performance may be grounds for immediate removal and failure of course.
- D. The faculty will inform the student in writing that he/she may not return to clinical.
- E. Documentation of this action will be placed in the students' file located in the Student Affairs Office.
