I. POLICY AND GENERAL STATEMENT

Minimum admission requirements for the PhD program area established by the PhD Council for the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston (UTHealth) Cizik School of Nursing. The PhD Council reviews each applicant on an individual basis according to admissions criteria. To reflect diversity within the school's educational environment, the PhD Council takes into account a multiplicity of factors in the admissions process. The Admission factors are not assigned a specific weight or point value. The PhD Council considers the totality of each application.

III. PROCEDURE

Criteria for Admission

Official transcript from each post-secondary institution is required. If the applicant attended any school within UTHealth, it is not necessary to request a transcript. Electronic submission is preferred. Official transcripts may be sent directly from post-secondary institutions to the Registrar's office at student-admissions@uth.tmc.edu. Transcripts will not be accepted if emailed from the student. Transcripts submitted on paper must be printed within six months of receipt and sealed in an envelope from the issuing institution. The application packet must include the following:

- For those applying to the BSN to PhD program, applicants must have a baccalaureate degree in nursing earned from a CCNE accredited program with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- For those applying to the post-master's PhD program, applicants must have a master's degree, preferably in nursing, from a CCNE accredited school with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- All applicants must have an unencumbered registered nursing license to practice in Texas.
 Evidence of national certification in a nursing specialty is desired, but not required for admission.

- One letter of reference is required from an individual with a doctoral degree who can
 address the applicant's ability to conduct independent research and potential for success
 in a PhD program. The person providing a letter of reference should complete the specified
 Applicant Letter of Reference form and provide a written statement describing the
 applicant's suitability for a PhD program.
- International applicants must submit official TOEFL scores. TOEFL scores can be no more than two years old. A minimum score of 550 is required on the paper exam, 213 on the computer-based exam, and 86 on the internet-based exam.
- If applicable, previous college coursework from another country, must be evaluated by Educational Credential Evaluators (ECE).
- Applicants must review the list of PhD faculty and identify a potential faculty advisor in specified area of interest. The applicant must contact and meet with the proposed faculty match(es) to discuss whether they will be a strong match to guide the applicant through the program. After the meeting, the proposed faculty match(es) need to complete the specified Faculty Support Form and send it to UTHealth Cizik School of Nursing PhD Admissions Committee at CSON-PhD-Admissions@uth.tmc.edu.
- A written essay identifying a specific area of research interest, research and professional goals, and how the proposed faculty match(es) will assist the applicant in attaining their professional goals. A provided Essay Template should be used to complete the essay. Completed essay should be sent to the Registrar's office at studentadmissions@uth.tmc.edu.
- A professional curriculum vitae that documents practice and/or teaching expertise, scholarly activities, presentations, and publications.
- A completed online application for admission and the non-refundable specified application fee.
