I. POLICY AND GENERAL STATEMENT

Based on the Cizik School of Nursing's concern for student health and for the welfare of clients with whom students come in contact, all students must meet the health requirements posted on the Cizik School of Nursing website.

II. DEFINITIONS

- A. Student: Applies to all full and part-time students.

III. PROCEDURE

- A. Students must conform to individual clinical agency policies regarding injuries and infectious diseases (such as needle stick, use of precautions reporting possible exposure, and refraining from clinical hours experiences when ill). Emergency care will be provided to students by the clinical agency. Cost for that care is the student's responsibility. A Report of Injury to a Student form (located in the Student Affairs Office) shall be completed and forwarded to the Safety, Health, Environment and Risk Management.
- B. All Cizik School of Nursing students shall conform to the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston policy on Infections from bloodborne pathogens (HOOP 158).
