## Financial Aid Basics

This document provides the estimated costs and expenses for the length of the program. The first part of this document labeled 'Tuition and Fee's are charges you can expect to receive on your semester bill. The direct and indirect expenses create an overall cost of attendance budget which is used to determine the amount of financial aid needed to attend the UTHealth School of Nursing. Federal regulations do not allow for students to receive funds over the cost of attendance.

## How will I receive my aid?

After you have registered for courses a bill will be generated through your MyUTH account (access provided after you have applied).
